## WELCOME HOME

Have you made the decision to follow Christ in years past, but your life never really changed? You may even be part of the 95% of Christians who have never shared their faith. Has your life reflected Christ at home, at work, at Church, or in the community?

Regardless of how you answer these questions, God continues to use you despite you. It's true. God continues to work in our lives even when we've strayed off course. God's plan never strays off course.

As men, it's not in our nature to surrender. However, that's exactly what Peter is teaching in our series study on 2 Peter 1:3-9. Surrender is trading our dreams for God's perfect plan, and then living it out. God has ALREADY given us EVERYTHING we need to live a Christ-centered life.
